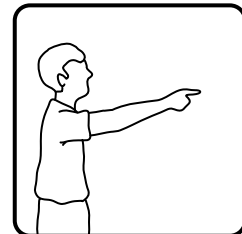
13. Echolalia (repeating words or phrases in place of normal language)



14. May not want cuddling or act cuddly



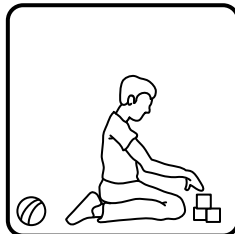
15. Not responsive to verbal cues; acts as deaf
